




Tassomai is an adaptive software that provides schools/students with essential knowledge practice in **3 core subjects in KS3 and KS4 (science, maths and English)**. It ensures students embed and practise knowledge daily and gives teachers and school leaders rich data on engagement and activity.

The program has been used by hundreds of schools to **boost** grades at GCSE and to close the attainment gap. Tassomai's impact data shows that students of all abilities improve in their academic performance as they use Tassomai, but the effect is even stronger for learners with lower initial attainment.

Schools pay for access to the program annually, on a perstudent basis. This price is based on how many full cohorts a school purchase for; a school buying for five cohorts pays **at most £5 perstudent** and this covers all 3 subjects.



Originally built as an adaptive quizzing program for GCSE science, **Tassomai is continually evolving**, with more subjects and new functionality added each year. In 2023 Tassomai will add 3 new subjects: **geography**, **history** & **computer science**!

As well as personalised **quizzes**, Tassomai also includes short explainer **videos** and **links** to carefully curated external resources.



Parent engagement is encouraged. Schools can activate **weekly progress reports for parents** and give them access to powerful tools like the Tree, where they can watch knowledge and understanding grow.





A student's **Tree** grows as they answer quizzes on Tassomai. It's an intuitive, interactive tool that makes it easy to see which topics a student understands and where they need help.
