THE CHALLENGE

RAISING STANDARDS IN MATHS AND ENGAGING PARENTS

'Maths has been a real focus for us over the last couple of years. In Wales we have annual tests which are published internally within schools. What we noticed, by looking at the standardised scores, is that there were a lot of children who were in the middle band.'

'We have tried different ways to increase the amount of children moving to the upper band, as well as building the confidence of those in the lower band to enable them to reach the next level.'

Ysgol Deiniol have tried different ways of sharing these goals around maths improvement with parents. The aim is to encourage a joined-up approach to learning at home and in school.

'Engaging with parents was key. We have had parents' evenings where a member of staff from the numeracy team has put together a presentation to show parents the strategies we are using in maths.'

'They've not been very well attended. After a long day at work, do parents really want to come into school, sit in a hall on small plastic chairs and be talked at? Probably not. What they do want though, is to go home and see what their child's been learning in maths without having to take an hour or two out of their day.'



We all truly believe that every child does matter, but with the amount of work that teachers have to do, it's not always possible to reach every child in the classroom.
