# **Brent Primary School**

Achieving the aims of the maths curriculum at home and in school









#### Introduction

#### Jess Baker, Maths-Leader at The Brent Primary

The Brent Primary School is an expanding twoform entry primary school in Dartford, Kent. They pride themselves on the friendly, caring environment they have created for children and friends of the school, working in partnership with parents to benefit their children.

Like every school in the UK, Brent Primary is continuing to adapt to the demands of the revised National Curriculum, with its new emphasis on reasoning skills, problem solving and deeper mathematical learning.

Jess Baker, teacher and subject leader in maths, was kind enough to share her experience of working with Whizz Education.

## The challenge

#### Adapting to the revised national curriculum

'With the new curriculum coming in, we knew it was going to be a lot more challenging. It's really important for us that children consolidate their learning in school, and we wanted them to be consolidating their learning at home too.

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'We were successfully setting a lot of creativebased tasks, writing tasks, a lot of research tasks, but teachers were struggling with giving out maths homework.

'It's so hard for teachers to manage with the differentiation and dedicating time to marking it all. It's just the pain of trying to fit it all into your daily timetable.'

The Brent Primary School are proud of their excellent relationship with parents, but sometimes help at home made things even trickier for maths homework.

'Children were being taught age-appropriate methods, but parents at home were trying to help by teaching them other methods from their own past experience.

'Children were just getting so confused. Before they are ready to move to other methods we need them to have a secure understanding of the basics, especially in the younger years.

'We needed a programme that was going to be appropriate for all children, no matter what their ability, which helped the parents to be supportive but doesn't need them to be too heavily involved.'

#### The solution

#### Maths-whizz at home and in school

'We know a lot of schools have Mathletics, but Catrina, our maths subject leader at the time, felt that Maths-Whizz was absolutely perfect.

We partnered with the Brent Primary School to help them introduce Maths-Whizz as a homework programme, linking personalised learning at home with thorough reports and classroom resources.

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#### The results

#### Increased progress and school-wide success

'Maths-Whizz has clearly supported progress in school. Our governors wanted us to show the impact of Maths-Whizz, so I did some number-crunching. I found that since the beginning of this academic year, all of the children that are on Maths-Whizz consistently show a clear difference in maths progress.

As their Headteacher, Mrs Sue Nicholson puts it: 'Children made accelerated progress in all year groups last year. Our Brent children are a credit to themselves, their families and their school.'
